



DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (BCP), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (ACP) and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (STC), for the period ending April 30, 2020.



PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

- In April, DEWA’s operational performance were struggling under challenging weather delay and Covid-19 public activity limitation around project area.
- By implementing prudent operations amid covid-19 condition, DEWA realized 1.52 million tonnes coal delivery in April 2020, grew by 26.66% compared to April 2019.
- For YTD, DEWA’s coal delivery reached 6.38 million tonnes. It escalated by 34.03% from 4.76 million tonnes in the same period of 2019.
- DEWA’s overburden performance was still influenced under challenging weather delay during April, it was recorded at 9.33 million bcm. Even so, company’s overburden volume spiked by 36.40% compared to April 2019.
- During January-April 2020, DEWA’s overburden was 41.47 million bcm or increased by 30.54% in comparison of 31.77 million bcm in the same period of 2019.
- The mining strip ratio in April was 2.89 for Asam Asam Coal Project, 8.03 for Bengalon Coal Project and 16.64 for Satui Coal Project.
