



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DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (“BCP”), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (“ACP”), and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (“STC”), for the period ending July 31, 2019.



PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS JULY 2019

- In line with planned production ramp-up by utilizing BRI Credit facility, DEWA’s production shows a trend reversal marked by a significant production growth in July 2019. These growths are driven by the gradual improvement on BCP & ACP fleet’s Physical Availability (PA), fleet recommencing in STC and less weather delay.
- Overburden removal recorded at 11.06 million bcm in July 2019, 71.73% increase from 6.44 million bcm in the previous month. Year to date July overburden removal reached 56.90 million bcm.
- Coal delivery recorded at 1.27 million tons in July 2019, 24.51% more than 1.02 million tons in the previous month. Year to date July, coal delivery was 8.47 million tonnes. Bengalon coal project delivered 4.90 million tonnes, Asam Asam coal project delivered 3.12 million tonnes, and Satui coal project delivered 457,186 tonnes.
- In July, strip ratio of DEWA’s three main projects are between 6.47 and 9.22.
