



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DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (BCP), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (ACP) and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (STC), for the period ending July 31, 2020.



**PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS**

- DEWA planned to add more capacity in Satui Coal Project (STC) and will discuss with client to increase overall contract volume in the area.
- Furthermore, as a key initiatives of strategic partnership with Thriveni, a world-class heavy equipment rebuild facility is being planned in Balikpapan. This will help put back more equipment into operations at a reasonable cost, preparing it to bid for additional mining contract from clients.
- DEWA made a decision to relieve a subcontractor in Bengalon Coal Project in July which will yield better economy, in the coming months DEWA intends to add more volume using owned fleet by increasing PA and Productivity.
- In July 2020, DEWA's overburden recorded at 7.03 million bcm, decreased by 36.46% compared to 11.06 million bcm in July 2019.
- DEWA's coal delivery was 918,797 tonnes in July 2020. The amount declined by 28.27% from 1.28 million tonnes in last year's July.
- DEWA's overburden removal was 68.38 million bcm, increased by 20.18% from 56.89 million bcm in the same period of 2019.
- YTD July 2020, DEWA's coal delivery stepped up by 19.39% to 10.03 million tonnes, from 8.41 million in January-July 2019.
- The mining strip ratio in July was 3.69 at ACP, 8.45 at BCP and 29.04 at STC.
