



DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (“BCP”), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (“ACP”), and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (“STC”), for the period ending June 30, 2019.



PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS JUNE 2019

- DEWA’s production performance was Impede by heavier weather delay than expected in all project site during June 2019 therefore production volume was curbed lower than the previous months.
- Overburden removal recorded at 6.44 million bcm in June 2019, 15.37% decrease from 7.61 million bcm in the previous month. Year to date June overburden removal reached 46.54 million bcm.
- Coal delivery recorded at 1.02 million tons in July 2019, 22.72% less than 1.32 million tons in the previous month. Year to date June, coal delivery was 7.06 million tons. Bengalon coal project delivered 4.03 million tonnes, Asam Asam coal project delivered 2.62 million tonnes, and Satui coal project delivered 410 thousand tons.
- In June, strip ratio of DEWA’s three main projects are between 5.69 and 6.93.
