



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DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (BCP), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (ACP) and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (STC), for the period ending March 31, 2020.



**PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS**

- DEWA showed an upturn in its March production. Company’s coal delivery increased by 8.91% month-on-month to 1.64 million tonnes. While the coal delivery improved by 28.04% compared to March 2019.
- During the first quarter of 2020, DEWA reached 4.23 million tonnes coal delivery, raised by 19.43% from the first quarter of 2019.
- However, DEWA’s overburden still impacted by weather as in March, it was recorded at 10.27 million bcm. Even so, company’s overburden spiked by 31% compared to March 2019.
- For the first quarter of 2020, DEWA’s overburden was 31.84 million bcm or increased by 27.78% than 24.92 million bcm in the same period of 2019.
- Mining strip ratio of in March was 3.61 for Asam Asam Coal Project, 9.04 for Bengalon Coal Project and 17.01 for Satui Coal Project.
