



DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (BCP), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (ACP) and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (STC), for the period ending May 31, 2020.



PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

- DEWA’s May 2020 performance started to rebound, as weather delay began to subside, public activity limitations slowly lifted, and spare parts supply chain gradually improves.
- The Company continues its implementation of covid-19 protocols and related safety measures in order to safeguard all employees, clients, vendors, and all parties involved from the ongoing pandemic.
- DEWA’s monthly overburden increased quite significantly by 37.10% from 7.61 million bcm in May 2019 to 10.44 million bcm in May 2020.
- YTD May 2020, DEWA realized 51.91 million bcm overburden, stepped up by 31.81% from 39.38 million bcm in the YTD May 2019.
- DEWA’s coal delivery showed a slight upturn to 1.37 million tonnes in May 2020, compared to May 2019. However, coal delivery will follow the overburden removal improvement in the coming months after coal expose.
- YTD May 2020, DEWA’s coal delivery reached 7.76 million tonnes, stepped up by 27.19% from 6.10 million tonnes in the YTD May 2019.
- Company’s mining strip ratio in varies from 3.09 for Asam Asam Coal Project, 7.83 for Bengalon Coal Project to 19.11 for Satui Coal Project.
