



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DEWA presents its monthly production report, for Bengalon Coal Mining Project in East Kalimantan (“BCP”), Asam Asam Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (“ACP”), and Satui Coal Mining Project in South Kalimantan (“STC”), for the period ending September 30, 2019.



PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS SEPTEMBER 2019

- DEWA continued its production uptrend, realizing company’s performance acceleration, after the equipment’s capacity ramp up.
- In September, DEWA’s overburden removal recorded at 13.44 million bcm, increased by 8.72% from the previous month. For YTD, DEWA realized 82.7 million bcm overburden, contributed mostly from Bengalon coal project.
- DEWA’s monthly coal delivery inclined by around 7% from 1.46 million tonnes in August to 1.57 million tonnes in September. While from January until the third quarter of 2019, DEWA’s coal delivery is accumulated at 11.44 million tonnes.
- Strip ratio for DEWA’s three coal mining projects are in a range of 5.59 to 10.21 during September.
