


Monthly Overburden Removal

(million bank cubic meters)




Monthly Coal Delivery

PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

- In May 2021, a peculiar off-season high weather delay hit the Asam-asam and Satui project sites resulting in lower available working hours and lower production volume. Contrastingly, Bengalon project went through much lower weather delays allowing BCP to improve its production volume.
- DEWA own equipment YTD May 2021 total material moved is 28.0 million bcm, increased by 35.2% vs YTD May 2020 of 20.7 million bcm.
- Subcontractor YTD May 2021 total material moved is 18.9 million bcm, decrease sharply by 49.0% vs YTD May 2020 of 37.1 million bcm.
- YTD May 2021 total material moved is 46.9 million bcm, decrease 18.9% vs YTD May 2020 of 57.8 million bcm resulting from management decision to discontinue a subcontractor in mid-2020 at our Bengalon project, since the contract was not economical. This decision resulted in improved margins despite falling production volumes and revenue, which is reflected in our financial performance.
- DH aims to continue this trend and aim to do 100% of its volume in-house using its own equipment, within a time span of 2 years. It plans a refurbishment program to put more equipment to use and aims to fund it through a mix of internal accruals and external borrowing.
